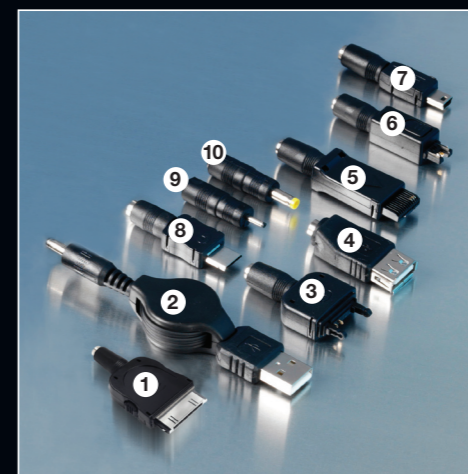


The powermonkey classic is the essential travel companion providing portable power for your gadgets when you need it most.

How to use your powermonkey classic:

To charge your digital devices:

- Switch your powermonkey classic on by sliding the rubberised button to the on position. The green LED will flash.
- If the red LED displays, your powermonkey classic needs to be recharged. See instructions below.
- Select appropriate tip for your digital device and attach to the powermonkey classic output cable or use the standard Nokia tip already attached to the output cable. If necessary tip is not included, visit www.powertraveller.com
- Connect powermonkey classic output cable to your digital device through its standard charging socket. When device is fully charged, remove powermonkey classic.
- When not in use, switch the rubberised button to the off position to conserve power.

Maximum reserve power available:

- All iPods - 40 hours
- Mobile phones - 96 hours
- Digital cameras - 1600 pictures
- Two-way radios - 24 hours
- PSPs - 5 hours
- MP3/MP4s - 6 hours
- PDA's - 48 hours

To recharge your powermonkey classic:

You can charge your powermonkey classic in two ways:

Mains charging

- Ensure powermonkey classic is switched off
- Connect mains charger to the powermonkey classic into the charging socket
- When charging the red LED will light up
- When fully charged the green LED will light up
- Remove from mains charger

USB charging

If you have a laptop or another device with a USB socket, it is possible to recharge your powermonkey classic using the USB cable provided.

Charging times:

Mains charging: To fully charge your powermonkey classic from the mains takes 3.5 hours.

USB charging: To fully charge your powermonkey classic using the USB cable takes 6 hours.
